
This year's Greenbuild, the U.S. Green Building Council's (USGBC) sustainable building conference, was held November 7-9 and offered us the opportunity to connect with peers, industry experts, and influential leaders as they shared insights on the green building movement and its diverse specialties. It was expected that this would be the largest Greenbuild yet, with over 20,000 attendees visiting educational sessions, exciting speakers, special events and tours, and an exhibit hall, and we hit that number early on.

Originally scheduled to take place in Los Angeles, the event was moved to Chicago's new West Building at McCormick Place in early 2007. The new West Building at McCormick Place is a LEED® registered project and Greenbuild was one of the first major shows to be held there. A cradle of American architecture, Chicago was also one of the first cities to adopt the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Green Building Rating System. It now has more building projects registered to earn this prestigious certification than any other city in the world.
